

Protecting Our Members Against COVID-19

Our lives have changed with the threat of COVID-19 forever present. This doesn't mean we have to stop enjoying socialising here at the club and the Committee have worked hard to put the measures in place to protect you, the Members, Your Family Members, Guests and Associate Members. These measures have been carefully constructed along Government Guidelines and the new Laws passed by the Government regarding clubs re-opening. In order for us to remain open to you all, we have issued the following Health and Safety measures, used alongside our risk assessment document, which must be adhered to within the club premises. **Please be clear, if you do not fall in-line with these guidelines and follow our new Health and Safety procedures in order that we remain open, you will be asked to leave the club and disciplinary proceedings will follow with a possible suspension of Membership.**

If you have ANY symptoms associated with COVID-19 (including but not exclusively high temperature, coughing and colds) you need not attempt to attend the club as you will not be allowed entry.

1. All members are always asked to carry their Membership Card (door entry card) at all times. NO ENTRY will be allowed in the club unless you have your Membership Card on your person.
2. Every single person who enters the building must register their details in the book held by the Doorman or at the Bar if the Doorman is not present. Details will be held for 21 days as per Government Guidelines for the track and trace system.
3. There are many Sanitising Stations within the club, strategically placed, including at the entrance. All persons walking past these stations MUST sanitise their hands. As soon as you enter the building USE THE SANITISER.
4. Staff will request that Members sanitise their hands before making a purchase at the bar. Failure to do so shall lead to refusal of service.
5. There are two service areas at the bar. Be aware provisions for TWO PEOPLE ONLY at each service area are allowed to queue at any one time. Please REMAIN SEATED and wait until a space becomes available before you start to queue.
6. Absolutely no loitering, drinking, or standing at the Service Bar or forming a queue of more than two people at any time.
7. Please use Contactless Card Payments at the bar rather than cash if possible.
8. SOCIAL DISTANCE always. Do not mix social bubbles between tables. Please keep all social bubbles at the same seating area, do not table hop.
9. Furniture has been arranged for the safe distancing of members. It is FORBIDDEN to move any of the furniture in the club from their designated positions.
10. Only the designated areas are to be occupied, any others are out of bounds until further notice.
11. When using the lotto machines or fruit machines, ALWAYS use hand sanitiser before and after each session. Remain seated at the stool provided. Do not 'loiter' around the machines.
12. Movement through the club should be kept to a minimum, where movement must be made follow the direction of the indicators and social distance – if the person in front is slow do not pass them.
13. No live music or entertainment is allowed, and any music played will be kept to a volume that does not interfere with conversation between attendees.
14. It is essential that when using the bathroom facilities, hand washing with soap and water for at least 20 seconds and sanitiser MUST BE USED EVERY VISIT.
15. If any person becomes unwell, they and the people at their table must vacate the building immediately.
